TOSCA-based deployment orchestration service on multiple IaaS

The PaaS Orchestrator service allows to coordinate the provisioning of virtualized compute and storage resources on distributed cloud infrastructures and the deployment of dockerized services and jobs on Mesos clusters. The service comes with a set of application/service topologies ready-to-use that can be deployed through a user-friendly web interface.
